



# TRAVEL INFORMATION

## BY AIR

The nearest airports to Cambridge are Stansted (30 miles) and Luton (40 miles). There's a direct train link to Cambridge from Stansted and Gatwick airports, and Heathrow airport is also easily accessible by train.

## BY SHUTTLE

National Express coaches usually stop on Parkside, next to Parker's Piece in the city center.

Buses regularly run from Stansted, Luton, Heathrow and Gatwick airports to the city center.

## BY PRIVATE TRANSFER

Alternatively, private transfers and taxis are available upon arrival at a London airport to Cambridge in about 1.5-2 hours, and it typically costs around £120-£160 depending on the airport and type of vehicle

## BY TRAIN

Cambridge is well connected by train:  
London Heathrow to Cambridge  
Train = 2hrs, 20 mins

London Gatwick to Cambridge  
Direct train = 1 hrs, 45 mins  
Stansted = 30 mins,  
Luton = 1 hr 20 mins by train
